#16 Count Intro - Weight on Left Foot to Start

S1: □ V STEP, STEP TAPS WITH CELEBRATE ARMS

- 1,2 Step R up and out to R diagonal(1) Step L up and out to L diagonal(2)
3,4 Return R to home underneath you(3) Return L to home underneath you(4)
(This draws a V on the floor)
5,6 Step R to R side as you lift L arm up to L diagonal(5) Tap L back diagonal as you bring L arm down and across body to R hip while looking to the R side(6)
7,8 Step L to L side as you lift R arm up to R diagonal(7) Tap R back diagonal as you bring R arm down and across body to L hip while looking L(8)

S2: □ SIDE BEHIND, SIDE TOGETHER FORWARD, WALK X2, TAP AND HIP

- 1,2 Turn face forward and step R to R(1) Step L behind R(2)
3&4 Step R to R(3) Bring L together(&) Step R fwd(4)
5,6 Walk fwd L(5) Walk fwd R(6)
7&8 Tap L toes fwd(7) Lift L hip up(&) Bring L hip down shifting weight to R(8)

S3: □ WALK BACK X2, COASTER STEP, ¼ SIDE ROICK RECOVER, BEHIND SIDE FORWARD

- 1,2 Walk back L(1) Walk back R(2)
3&4 Step L back(3) Bring R back stepping together(&) Step L fwd(4)
5,6 Make a ¼ L as you rock R to R side(5) Recover weight to L(6)
7&8 Step R behind L(7) Step L to L side(&) Step R fwd and slightly across L(8)

S4: □ POINT FRONT SIDE, SAILOR STEP, STEP ½ X2

- 1,2 Point L toe fwd(1) Point L toe side(2)
3&4 Step L behind R(3) Step R slightly to R side(&) Step L slight to L side(4)
5,6 Step R fwd(5) Turn ½ turn L shifting weight fwd onto L foot(6)
7,8 Step R fwd(7) Turn ½ turn L shifting weight fwd onto L foot(8)

RINSE, REPEAT, ENJOY!
