Start on vocals - Intro: 16 counts

Tag on wall 4 facing (9:00) & wall 9 facing (12:00)

## SEC.I-VINE RIGHT WITH 1/4 TURN RIGHT, PIVOT 3/4 TURN RIGHT, CROSS, SIDE, SYNCOPATED JAZZ BOX 1/4 TURN RIGHT

- 1- Step RF to Right side
- 2- Cross LF behind RF
- 3- Turn 1/4 to Right stepping RF fwd
- 4- Step LF fwd
- &- Pivot 1/2 turn Right
- 5- Make a 1/4 turn Right step LF to Left side
- 6- Cross RF behind LF
- 7- Step LF to Left side
- 8- Cross RF over LF
- &- Step LF back
- 1- Turn 1/4 to Right step RF to Right side

## SEC.II-CROSS ROCK, CHASSE 1/4 TURN LEFT, PIVOT 1/2 TURN LEFT, KICK-BALL-STEP

- 2- Step LF fwd & cross
- 3- Recover on RF
- 4- Step LF to Left side
- &- Close RF beside LF
- 5- Turn 1/4 to Left stepping LF fwd
- 6- Step RF fwd
- 7- Pivot 1/2 turn Left
- 8- Kick RF fwd
- &- Step RF next to LF (ball)
- 1- Step LF fwd

## SEC.III-FULL TURN LEFT (ROLLING FWD), LOCK SHUFFLE FWD, PIVOT 3/4 TURN RIGHT WITH CHASSE

- 2- Make a 1/2 turn Left stepping RF back
- 3- Make a 1/2 turn Left stepping LF fwd
- 4- Step RF fwd
- &- Lock LF behind RF
- 5- Step RF fwd
- 6- Step LF fwd
- 7- Pivot 1/2 turn Right
- 8- Turn 1/4 to Right step LF to Left side
- &- Close RF beside LF
- 1- Step LF to Left side

## SEC.IV-CROSS POINT 2X, JAZZ BOX, TOGETHER

- 2- Step RF fwd & cross
- 3- Point LF toe to Left side
- 4- Step LF fwd & cross

- 5- Point RF toe to Right side
- 6- Cross RF over LF
- 7- Step LF back
- 8- Step RF to Right side
- &- Step LF together

**Begin again**

**TAGS: 2X Tags the first and second tags are the same**

**First tags 4 counts on wall 4 facing (9:00)**

**SIDE-TOUCH 2X WITH CLAP 1X**

- 1- Step RF to Right side
- 2- Touch LF toe beside RF with clap
- 3- Step LF to Left side
- 4- Touch RF toe beside LF with clap

**Second tag on wall 9 facing (12:00)**
