Info: Starts after 32 counts

[1 – 8] Grapevine R (With Hitches), Side Rock, Rock Back

1,2,3,4 RF to side (1), LF behind RF (2), RF to side (3), LF across (4)

Optional: at the same time with each step, hitch knee of you other leg to make it more look like 'gabberen'

5,6 Rock R to side (5), recover (6) 7,8 Rock R back (7), recover (8)

[9 – 16] (¼ Turn L, Hitch)2x, Step-Lock-Step Daig. Fwd., Kick Daig. Fwd.

1,2 1/4 turn L step RF Back (1) [09.00], hitch L (2)

5-8 RF daig. fwd. (5), lock LF behind RF (6), RF diag. fwd. (7), kick LF fwd. (8)

[17 – 24] Step Fwd., Point R, 1/4 Turn R Step R Together, Point L, Step Fwd., Point R, Step L Fwd., Point L

1,2 LF fwd. (1), point RF to side (2)

3,4 1/2 turn R step RF together, slightly fwd. (3) [09.00], point LF to side (4)

5,6 LF fwd. (5), point RF to side (6) 7,8 RF fwd. (7), point LF to side (8)

[25 – 32] Walk L+R Fwd. With Holds Into ½ Turn L, Walk L-R-L Fwd., Hold

1,2 Walk LF fwd. (1), hold (2) 3,4 Walk RF fwd. (3), hold (4)

Walk counts 1-4 into ½ turn over L-shoulder ending up facing 03.00

5-8 Walk LF fwd. (5), walk RF fwd. (6), walk LF fwd. (7), hold (8) [03.00]

Tag: After wall 10 you're facing 06.00. There will be a small tag in the music where someone says: 'Welkom in Europa, jongen!' (Wich means 'Welcome to Europe, man!') During these four counts, stop dancing, 'push' both hands fwd so they'll cross each other and say: 'Welcome to Europe, man' in your own language' After these for counts, the 'beat' drops and a 'raving/hardcore/gabber' part in the music starts. During these 32 counts of the music, try to dance the dance more 'extremely' then it normally is. Example: instead of a normal grapevine in section one, stomp it. And hitch high. Kick hard fwd., etc.
