# Funky Stuff

**Count:** 40

Wand: 2

Ebene: Improver line/contra dance

Choreograf/in: Karen Bleuer (USA)

Musik: (Everything I Do) Got to Be Funky - Maurice John Vaughn

## STEP TOUCHES, FUNKY WALK

- 1-2 Step right to right, touch left beside right
- 3-4 Step left to left, touch right beside left
- 5-8 Walk back right-left-right-left slightly twisting opposite heel out (boogie walk backwards)

### **ROCK STEPS, SHUFFLES**

- 1-2 Rock right back, rock left in place
- 3&4 Step right slightly forward, step left beside right, step right slightly forward
- 5-6 Rock left back, rock right in place
- 7&8 Step left slightly forward, step right beside left, step left slightly forward

### STEP SLIDES, ¼ PADDLE TURNS

- 1-2 Step right forward, slide left to right
- 3-4 Repeat counts 1-2
- 5-6 Step right forward, roll hips to the left as you pivot 1/4 turn left changing weight to left
- 7-8 Repeat counts 5-6

### HOP, BOUNCE & BUMP

- Hop forward right-left &1
- 2-4 Standing on the balls of your feet bounce on your heels three times and bump right hips left on each bounce
- &5 Repeat &1 one time
- 6-8 Repeat 2-4 one time

### **BASIC STEP TOGETHER RIGHT-LEFT**

- 1-2 Step right to right, step left beside right
- 3-4 Step right to right, touch left beside right
- 5-6 Step left to left, step right beside left
- 7-8 Step left to left, touch right beside left

### REPEAT

As an extra styling challenge, hits the breaks that occur on every verse except the last. Use the following for a 4-count break:

- 1 Stop Hold
- 2
- Execute a 2-count body roll in the direction of flow of dance 3-4

If you start dancing on count 16 of the song, the breaks occur as follows:

- А 3rd wall counts 33-40
- В 4th wall complete one wall, no break
- С 5th wall counts 1-8
- D 6th wall counts 9-16
- Е 7th wall counts 17-24
- F 8th wall counts 25-33
- G Three walls with no breaks. Two are instrumental.
- Н Counts 1-8
- Counts 9-16

Don't worry about memorizing that and remembering the wall you are on. You will hear the break coming.
