Step Scuff, Across Scuff, Cross Shuffle While Curving 1/4 Left

1,2,3,4 Step fwd on R, Scuff L fwd, Step L across R, Scuff R fwd

The following cross shuffle curves a 1/4 turn left (facing 9 0'clock)

5,6,7,8 Step R across L, Step L to left, Step R across L, Step L to left

Across Scuff, Across Scuff, Cross Shuffle While Curving 1/4 Left

9,10,11,12 Step R across L, Scuff L fwd, Step L across R, Scuff R fwd

The following cross shuffle curves a 1/4 turn left (facing 6 0'clock)

13,14,15,16 Step R across L, Step L to left, Step R across L, Step L to left

Weave Left, Cross Rock/Replace, Side Hold

17,18,19,20 Step R across L, Step L to left, Step R behind L, Step L to left 21,22,23,24 Cross/rock R over L, Rock/replace wt on L, Step R to right, Hold

Cross Rock/Replace, 1/4 Turn Hold, Step Pivot 1/4, Stomp Stomp

25,26,27,28 Cross/rock L over R, Rock/replace wt on R, Making 1/4 left step fwd on L, Hold

29,30 Step fwd on R, Pivot 1/4 left transferring wt to L

31,32 Stomp R beside L, Stomp L beside R

4 Count Rocking Chair, Two Heel Struts Fwd

33,34,35,36 Rock/step fwd on R, Rock back on L, Rock/step back on R, Rock fwd on L *Restart

37,38,49,40 Heel strut fwd R,L

Step Pivot 1/4, Step Fwd Hold, Step Pivot 1/4, Step Fwd Hold

41,42,43,44 Step fwd on R, Pivot 1/4 left transferring wt to L, Step fwd on R, Hold Step fwd on L, Pivot 1/4 right transferring wt to R, Step fwd on L, Hold

Vine Right Touch, Side Touch, Touch Out Touch Beside

49,50,51,52 Step R to right, Step L behind R, Step R to right, Touch L beside R
53,54,55,56 Step L to left, Touch R beside L, Touch R toe to right, Touch R beside L

Fwd Back, Back Hold, 1/4 Turn Together, 1/4 Turn Hold

57.58,59,60 Rock/step fwd on R, Rock back on L, Step back on R, Hold

61,62,63,64 Step back on L making 1/4 left, Step R beside L, Making 1/4 left step fwd on L, Hold

Unfortunately, none of us ever get through life without experiencing 'crvin' eyes'.

Perhaps that is a good thing because I believe that the ability to shed tears is one of the things that separates us from other animals species... and I guess that's true because I have never seen my dog shed tears, not even when I know she is feeling very sad.
