#### PART 1: 16 COUNTS

### CHA CHA ROCKS RIGHT AND LEFT OR UP AND BACK

1 2 3&4 Going to the right, left, RLR

5 6 7&8 Going to the left, step on left, right, LRL

#### CROSS ROCK, CHA CHAS TO LEFT AND RIGHT

1 2 3&4 Cross right over left, recover on left, RLR turning to face oppose wall

5 6 7&8 Cross left over right, recover on right, LRL returning to front

#### PART 2: 16 COUNTS

#### STEP, SCUFF, TURNING WALK, STEP, SCUFF, TURNING WALK

1 2 3 4 Turn to face left scuffing with right foot, step on right foot, step left then right

To the right, scuff, step on left, step right then left quarter turn stepping back on right, slide

left foot

#### **REPEAT STEPS 1-8 ABOVE**

# KEEP REPEATING DANCING ENTIRE DANCE ON ALL FOUR WALLS REPEATEDLY UNTIL MUSIC STOPS
