Count: 48

Wall: 2

Level: Intermediate

Music: An Old Country Waltz - Terry & Jenny Bennetts



(24 count intro)

Step Back Hook Hold, Waltz Fwd 1/4, Step Back Hook Hold, Waltz Fwd 1/4

1,2,3 Step back on R, Hook L across R, Hold
4,5,6 Waltz fwd L,R,L making 1/4 turn left
7,8,9 Step back on R, Hook L across R, Hold
10,11,12 Waltz fwd L,R,L making 1/4 turn left (now facing the back)

Make 1/2 Waltz, Step Fwd Touch Hold, Step Back Drag, Step Back Drag Together

13,14,15 Making 1/2 left waltz back R,L,R
16,17,18 Step fwd on L, Touch R beside L, Hold
19,20,21 Step back on R, Drag L heel towards R for 2 counts
22,23,24 Step back on L, Drag R heel towards L, Step R beside L

Diagonal Waltz, Step Back Touch Hold, Diagonal Waltz, Step Back Touch Hold

25,26,27 Facing the right corner waltz fwd L,R,L
28,29,30 Step back on R, Touch L beside R, Hold
31,32,33 Turning towards the left corner waltz fwd L,R,L
4,35,36 Step back on R, Touch L beside R, Hold

Step Touch Hold, 1/2 Waltz, Step, Step Hook Step Down, Step Touch Hold

37,38,39 Turning to front wall step fwd on L, Touch R beside L, Hold
40,41,42 Making 1/2 left (over left shoulder) waltz back R,L,R
43,44,45 Step fwd on L, Hook R behind L, Step R behind L
46,47,48 Step fwd on L, Touch R beside L, Hold

Begin again.

***There is a 6 count tag at the end of wall 3.**

1,2,3 Step R to right, Touch L beside R, Hold
4,5,6 Step L to left, Touch R beside L, Hold

***There is an 18 count tag at the end of the 6th wall (facing the front).**

Please do the 6 beat tag above and add the following 12 steps - - restart dance

7,8,9 Waltz back R,L,R making 1/2 turn left
10,11,12 Step fwd on L, Touch R beside L, Hold
13,14,15 Waltz back R,L,R making 1/2 turn left
16,17,18 Step fwd on L, Touch R beside L, Hold

These Aussie singers have a great old fashioned sound—and I love that!

The waltz is pretty fast so you will have to keep your wits about you., but the steps are all very manageable so you shouldn't have a problem.
