16 count intro

Step Fwd Rock Fwd Back, Shuffle Back, Rock Back Fwd, Step Fwd

1,2,3 Step fwd on R, Rock/step fwd on L, Rock back on R

4&5 Shuffle back L,R,L

6,7,8 Rock/step back on R, Rock fwd on L, Step fwd on R

Step Pivot 1/4, Cross Shuffle, Side Rock Replace, Behind Side Across

9,10 Step fwd on L, Pivot 1/4 right transferring wt to R

11&12 Cross/shuffle right stepping L,R,L

13,14 Rock/step R to right, Rock/replace wt sideways onto L

15&16 Step R behind L, Step L to left, Step R across L

Big Step Left Side, Big Step Right Slide, Rock Fwd Back, 1/4 Turn Touch

17,18	Big step to the left on L, Slide R to L
19,20	Big step to the right on R, Slide L to R
21,22	Rock/step fwd on L, Rock back on R

23,24 Making 1/4 left step L to left side, Touch R beside L *restart here

Rock Fwd Back, 1/2 Shuffle, Rock Fwd Back, Coaster Step

25,26	Rock/step fwd on R, Rock back on L
27&28	Making 1/2 right shuffle fwd R,L,R
29.30	Rock/step fwd on L. Rock back on R

31&32 Step back on L, Step R beside L, Step fwd on L (coaster)

*There is a restart every time she sings 'Two Shades Of Blue" That happens after count 24 on walls 2, 5, 8 (facing the back)

*There is a 4 count tag at the end of wall 3 (facing the front)

4 Count Rocking Chair

1,2,3,4 Rock/step fwd on R, Rock back on L, Rock/step back on R, Rock fwd on L

Although this dance has restarts and tags, they are really an integral part of the dance and don't feel like an 'Extra' at all. You will just have to give it a go to realize what I mean by that. It is a beautiful song and you will enjoy dancing to it I am sure.

We still do Terry Hogan's dance to this song and we love it, but it's a bit too difficult for some dancers and hence the request for something easier. I was happy to oblige, of course! (-:
