20 count intro.

Rock Fwd Back, Shuffle Back, Rock Back Fwd, Shuffle Fwd

1,2,3&4 Rock/step fwd on L, Rock back on R, Shuffle back L,R,L

5,6,7&8 Rock/step back on R, Rock fwd on L, Shuffle fwd R,L,R

Touch Hold, Coaster Back, Touch Hold, Coaster Back

9,10 Touch L toe fwd, Hold

11&12 Step back on L, Step R beside L, Step fwd on L (coaster)

13,14 Touch R toe fwd, Hold

15&16 Step back on R, Step L beside R, Step fwd on R (coaster)

Step Pivot 1/4, Triple Step, Step Pivot 1/4, Triple Step

17,18 Step fwd on L, Pivot 1/4 right transferring wt to R

19&20 Triple step on the spot L,R,L

21,22 Step fwd on R, Pivot 1/4 left transferring wt to L

23&24 Triple step on the spot R,L,R

Rock Fwd Back, 1/4 Triple Step, Step Pivot 1/4, Triple Step

25,26 Rock/step fwd on L, Rock back on R

27&28 Making 1/4 left triple step L to left, Step R,L together

29,30 Step fwd on R, Pivot 1/4 left transferring wt to L

31&32 Triple step on the spot R,L,R

***There is a 12 count tag at the end of walls 4 and 8**

TAG: Rock Fwd Back, Walk Back, Rock Back Fwd, Walk Fwd, 4 Count Rocking Chair

1,2,3,4 Rock/step fwd on L, Rock back on R, Walk back L,R

5,6,7,8 Rock/step back on L, Rock fwd on R, Walk fwd L,R

9,10,11,12 Rock/step fwd on L, Rock back on R, Rock/step back on L, Rock fwd on R

This is a lovely song that Ilse has sent to me. She requested a beginner dance so I hope that is what this dance is - although with 2x 12 count tags I doubt it! That's why I called it Upper Beginner which is probably more appropriate. These days it is hard to recognise exactly what a 'beginner' dance is supposed to be. Whatever... I hope you enjoy the dance as well as the song! I know I did!
