Count: 48

Wall: 1

Level: Beginner

Choreographer: Unknown - March 2013

Music: Three Steps To Heaven - Eddie Cochran

or: any music of your choice!



Steps written up by Steve & Denise Bisson (Phoenix LDC, Northern Cyprus)

Intro: 16 counts – start on vocals

(1-8) CROSS ROCK, SIDE ROCK X 2

- 1-2 Cross rock right over left, recover weight on left
- 3-4 Rock right to right side, recover weight on left
- 5-6-7-8 Repeat counts 1-4

(9-16) RIGHT SWIVET, LEFT SWIVET X 2

- 1-2 Weight on right heel and left toe swivel toes to right, return feet to centre
- 3-4 Weight on left heel and right toe swivel toes to left, return feet to centre
- 5-6-7-8 Repeat counts 1-4

(17-22) KICK BALL CHANGE X 2, STEP ½ PIVOT TURN

- 1&2 Kick right forward, step right beside left, step left in place
- 3&4 Kick right forward, step right beside left, step left in place
- 5-6 Step right forward, pivot ½ turn left [6.00]

(23-28) KICK BALL CHANGE X 2, STEP ½ PIVOT TURN

- 1&2 Kick right forward, step right beside left, step left in place
- 3&4 Kick right forward, step right beside left, step left in place
- 5-6 Step right forward, pivot ½ turn left [12.00]

(29-38) FORWARD SHUFFLES X 4, STEP ½ PIVOT TURN

- 1&2 Step right forward, step left beside right, step right forward
- 3&4 Step left forward, step right beside left, step left forward
- 5&6-7&8 Repeat steps 1&2-3&4
- 9-10 Step right forward, pivot ½ turn left [6.00]

(39-48) FORWARD SHUFFLES X 4, STEP ½ PIVOT TURN

- 1&2 Step right forward, step left beside right, step right forward
- 3&4 Step left forward, step right beside left, step left forward
- 5&6-7&8 Repeat steps 1&2-3&4
- 9-10 Step right forward, pivot ½ turn left [12.00]

*Optional: to make this a 4 wall dance, steps 9-10 can be done as a ¼ turn left [3.00]

REPEAT

Note: For the more experienced dancers, Steps 31&32, 33&34, 41&42, 43&44 can danced as shuffle ½ turns
