

County Line Shuffle (L/P)

COPPER KNOB
BY STEPHEN

Count: 32

Wall: 4

Level: Beginner - Partner Line or Single Line



Choreographer: Unknown - December 2013

Music: Neon Moon - Brooks & Dunn : (abridged version - cut at 3:37minutes)

Intro: 16 counts for Neon Moon

For a Christmas music version use "Tropical Christmas" by The Bellamy Brothers – intro: 16 counts

RIGHT HEEL, RIGHT TOE, RIGHT FORWARD SHUFFLE, ROCK STEP, LEFT BACK SHUFFLE

- 1-2 Touch right heel forward, touch right toe back
3&4 Step forward right, close left beside right, step forward right
5-6 Rock forward on left, rock back onto right
7&8 Step back left, close right beside left, step back left

ROCK STEP, RIGHT FORWARD SHUFFLE, STEP 1/2 PIVOT TURN, LEFT FORWARD SHUFFLE

- 1-2 Rock back on right, rock forward onto left
3&4 Step forward right, close left beside right, step forward right
5-6 Step forward left, pivot ½ turn right
7&8 Step forward left, close right beside left, step forward left

1/4 TURN LEFT SIDE SHUFFLE, ROCK STEP, LEFT SIDE SHUFFLE, ROCK STEP

- 1&2 Step right to right side making ¼ turn left, close left beside right, step right to right side [3:00]
3-4 Rock back on left, rock forward onto right
5&6 Step left to left side, close right beside left, step left to left side
7-8 Rock back on right, rock forward onto left

***When partner dancing, the man will be behind the woman when making the ¼ turn and for the side shuffle etc.**

1/4 TURN LEFT SIDE SHUFFLE, ROCK STEP, LEFT FORWARD SHUFFLE, STEP 1/4 PIVOT TURN

- 1&2 Step right to right side making ¼ turn left, close left beside right, step right to right side [12:00]
3-4 Rock back on left, rock forward onto right
5&6 Step forward left, close right beside left, step forward left
7-8 Step forward on right, pivot ¼ turn left [9:00]

***When partner dancing, the man returns to the side position when making the ¼ turn and for the forward shuffle etc.**

REPEAT

Note: This dance has been adapted from the original step sheet for "County Line Cha Cha" – a 20 count Beginner line dance, choreographer unknown, the first 16 counts are the same but we have added a further 16 counts making it a 32 count dance.
