Music: Gori More, traditional by many



This is adapted from a Serbian Turbofolk Dance taught by Marija Krapceвич, the Director and Choreographer for Aska Kolo Ansambl, at Social Dances of the World Explore Serbia! Workshop on May 27, 2007.

Turbofolk dances are dances done to the popular Turbofolk music. Gori More is done to the tune Gori More. The song is about a man who sees a beautiful woman and the sea seems to be on fire and the hills seem to melt.

Dance is in 4/4 time. Tempo is moderately relaxed.

SIDE STEP TO RIGHT

1 - 3 Step R Step L together Step R
4 Lift L

WEAVE RIGHT

5 - 7 Step L in front of right, Step R to the side, Step L behind right
8 Lift R

WEAVE LEFT

9 - 11 Sweep R in back of Left, Step L to the left side, Step R in front of left
12 Lift L

SIDE STEP TO LEFT

13 - 15 Step L Step R together Step L
16 Lift R

Notice the middle two figures (counts 5-12) are called a circle weave.
