#### Dance begins on vocals after 24 counts

#### LEFT TWINKLE, RIGHT TWINKLE

1, 2, 3 Cross L over R, step R next to L, step L next to R (12:00)

4, 5, 6 Cross R over L, step L next to R, step R next to L

#### CROSS, POINT, HOLD, BACK, POINT, HOLD

1, 2, 3 Cross L over R, point R to side, hold 4, 5, 6 Step R behind L, point L to side, hold

#### LEFT TWINKLE, RIGHT TWINKLE

1, 2, 3 Cross L over R, step R next to L, step L next to R 4, 5, 6 Cross R over L, step L next to R, step R next to L

#### CROSS, POINT, HOLD, BACK, POINT, HOLD

1, 2, 3 Cross L over R, point R to side, hold 4, 5, 6 Step R behind L, point L to side, hold

#### CROSS, 1/4 LEFT, STEP, WALTZ BACK

1, 2, 3 Cross L over R, step R back turning 1/4 left, step L next to R (9:00)

4, 5, 6 Step R back, step L next to R, step R next to L

#### WALTZ FORWARD, WALTZ FORWARD

1, 2, 3 Step L fwd, step R next to L, step L next to R 4, 5, 6 Step R fwd, step L next to R, step R next to L

# FWD, BRUSH, BACK, DRAG

1, 2, 3 Step L fwd, brush R ball forward and upwards (2 counts)

4, 5, 6 Step R back, slide L to touch next to R (2 counts)

## FWD, BRUSH, BACK, DRAG

1, 2, 3 Step L fwd, brush R ball forward and upwards (2 counts) 4, 5, 6 Step R back, slide L to touch next to R (2 counts)

# \* TAG: 12-count Tag on wall 5 after 12 counts (facing 12 o'clock)

### CROSS, ¼ LEFT, STEP, WALTZ BACK, WALTZ FWD ¼ TURN, WALTZ BACK

1, 2, 3	Cross L over R, st	ep R back <sup>,</sup>	turnina ¼ left.	. step L next	to R (9:00)

4, 5, 6 Step R back, step L next to R, step R next to L

1, 2, 3 Step L fwd, ¼ turn left stepping R next to L, step L next to R (6:00)

4, 5, 6 Step R back, step L next to R, step R next to L
