**Intro: 32 counts (on modified version), start on vocals.**

**Sec 1: Side, touch+clap R & L; vine 3, touch+snap;**

1-4 Side R, touch L together + clap your hands, Side L, touch R together + clap your hands;  
5-8 Side R, cross L in back, side R, touch L together + snap your fingers;

**Sec 2: Repeat to L;;**

1-4 Side L, touch R together + clap your hands, Side R, touch L together + clap your hands;  
5-8 Side L, cross R in back, side L, touch R together + snap your fingers;

**Sec 3: Forward 3, kick; vine 3, touch;**

1-4 Walk forward 3, kick L;  
5-8 Side L, cross R in back, side L, touch R together;

**Sec 4: Backwards 3, kick; behind, side, cross, ¼L;**

1-4 Walk backward 3, kick L;  
5-8 Cross L behind, side R, cross L in front, turn ¼ L on L feed;
