**Intro 32 Counts.**

(One Tag at end of wall 4 for 12 counts, do Cross Point R/L Fwd. R/L Back, then one basic step back and fwd.)

**Step Fwd. R/L (Big Steps)**

1-4 Step Fwd. R diagonally, Touch L to R, (2 counts) Step Fwd. L diagonally, Touch R to L, (2 counts)

**Slide R Side, Touch R Toe to Side and Back, Repeat on L**

1-4 Step wide R side, Touch L to R, (2 counts) touch L toe to L side, Touch L to R, (4 counts)

1-4 Step wide L side, Touch R to L, (2 counts) touch R toe to R side, Touch R to L (4 counts)

**Slow Jazz Box turning ¼ R**

1-4 Step R over L, Step back on L, Turning ¼ R, Step on R, Step on L,

**Tag at the end of wall 4 for 12 counts, do a cross point R/L fwd. R/L back, then one basic step back and fwd. Then start over at the beginning.**

1-8 Step R fwd., Touch L to L side, Step L fwd. Touch R to R side, repeat going back

1-4 Step R back, step L to R, Step fwd. R, step L to R
