TURNING VINE:

1-3 Step right to right; swing left across right (to begin ½ turn to right); swing right behind left (to

complete full turn)

4 Step left across right

GRAPEVINE RIGHT:

5-7 Vine right (step right to right; step left behind; step right to right)

8 Step left beside right

SHUFFLE/ROCK:

9&10 Shuffle forward on right, left, right

11 Rock forward on left12 Rock back on right

13&14 Shuffle back on left, right, left

15 Rock back on right16 Rock forward on left

HEEL/TOE & TURN:

Touch right heel forward
 Touch right toe behind
 Step right heel forward
 Turn ½ turn to left

TURNING VINE:

21-23 Step right to right; swing left across right (to begin ½ turn to right); swing right behind left (to

complete full turn)

24 Step left across right

GRAPEVINE RIGHT:

25-27 Vine right (step right to right, left behind, step right to right)

28 Step left beside right

SHUFFLE/ROCK:

29&30 Shuffle forward on right, left, right

Rock forward on left Rock back on right

33&34 Shuffle back on left, right, left

35 Rock back on right 36 Rock forward on left

STRUTTIN' JAZZ BOX & TURN:

37-38 Touch right toe across left foot; slap heel down 39-40 Touch left toe behind right foot; slap heel down

41-42 Turn ½ turn to right (swing right foot out to right) touching right to out to right at the same

time; slap right heel down

43-44 Touch left toe beside right; slap heel down

SHUFFLE/ROCK:

45&46 Shuffle forward on right, left, right

47 Rock forward on left 48 Rock back on right

49&50 Shuffle back on left, right, left

Rock back on rightRock forward on left

REPEAT

VARIATION

Steps 1-4 and 21-24 can be done as a straight grapevine for those who may have equilibrium problems.
