## SIDE, BEHIND, CROSS, SIDE, 1/4 TURN LEFT, LOCK FORWARD, 1/2 TURN RIGHT

1            Step left to left,  
2&3        Cross right behind left, cross left over right, step right to right  
4&5        Cross left behind right, cross right over left, 1/4 turn left stepping forward on left  
6&7        Step forward on right, lock left behind right, step forward on right  
8&1        Step forward on left, 1/2 turn right, step forward on left (3:00)

## 3/4 TURN LEFT, SIDE BEHIND CROSS, CHASSE RIGHT, TOUCH

2&3        1/2 turn left stepping back on right, 1/4 turn left stepping left to left, cross right over left  
4&5        Step left to left, step right behind left, cross left over right  
6&7        Step right to right, step left next to right, step right to right  
8            Touch left next to right (6:00)

## WALK X 3, 3/4 TURN LEFT, SAILOR X 2

1-2-3      Step forward on left, right, left  
4&5        Step forward on right, 1/2 turn left, (weight on left), 1/4 turn left stepping right to right  
6&7        Step left behind right, step right to right, step left to left  
8&1        Step right behind left, step left to left, step right to right (9:00)

## STEP TAP, LOCK BACK x 2, 1/2 TURN RIGHT

2-3        Step forward on left, tap right behind left (facing slightly to a right diagonal)  
4&5        Step back on right, cross left over right, step back on right (still facing slightly right)  
6&7        Step back on left, cross right over left, step back on left (facing slightly left)  
8            1/2 turn right, stepping forward on right (3:00)

Repeat
