Intro: 8 counts - No tags or restarts

## [1-8] DIAGONAL STEP TOUCH FORWARD

1,2                      Step Right slightly diagonally forward, Touch Left beside  
3,4                      Step Left slightly diagonally forward, Touch Right beside  
5,6                      Step Right slightly diagonally forward, Touch Left beside  
7,8                      Step Left slightly diagonally forward, Touch Right beside

## [9-16] R HEEL, TOE, STEP, TOUCH, L HEEL, TOE, STEP, TOUCH

1-2                      Right heel forward, Right toe beside Left  
3,4                      Step Right to side, Touch Left beside  
5,6                      Left heel forward, Left toe beside Right  
7,8                      Step Left to side, Touch Right beside

## [17-24] K-STEP

1,2                      Step Right forward at a diagonal, Touch Left beside Right & Clap  
3,4                      Step Left back to home, Touch Right beside Left & Clap  
5,6                      Step Right back at a diagonal, Touch Left beside Right & Clap  
7,8                      Step Left forward to home, Touch Right beside Left & Clap

## [25-32] ¼ TURNING ROCKING CHAIR

1,2                      Rock Right forward, Recover Left  
3,4                      Rock back on Right and turn 1/8 to Left (11:30ish), Recover Left  
5,6                      Rock Right forward, Recover Left  
7,8                      Rock back on Right and turn 1/8 to Left (9:00), Recover Left

Ending: At the end of wall 13 you will be facing 12:00. As the music slows to an ending, instead of turning the Rocking Chair just stay facing forward as the song ends.

I could hear a couple of places where there could have been a restart or a tag, but if you keep dancing through it, the dance flows nicely with the music.
