**Intro: 36 counts – 5 easy to follow tags!**

## **TOE STRUTS FORWARD, SLOW COASTER STEP, STEP TOGETHER**

1-2                      Touch right toes forward, slap right heel down  
3-4                      Touch left toes forward, slap left heel down  
5-6                      Rock back right, step left back beside right  
7-8                      Step right forward, step left beside right

## **WEAVE RIGHT, STEP RIGHT, HOLD, BACK ROCK**

1- 2                      Step right to right side, cross left behind right.  
3- 4                      Step right to right side, cross left over right.  
5- 6                      Step right to right side, Hold.  
7- 8                      Rock back on left, recover forward onto right

## **WEAVE LEFT, STEP LEFT, HOLD, BACK ROCK**

1- 2                      Step left to left side, cross right behind left.  
3- 4                      Step left to left side, cross right over left.  
5- 6                      Step left to left side, Hold.  
7- 8                      Rock back on right, recover forward onto left.

## **JAZZ BOX TURN ¼ RIGHT X 2**

1-2                      Cross right over left, step left back  
3-4                      Step right to right side making ¼ turn right [3.0], step left beside right  
5-6                      Cross right over left, step left back  
7-8                      Step right to right side making ¼ turn right [6.0], step left beside right

**Tag – 4 counts at the end of walls 2, 4, 6, 8 & 10 (all on home wall) –**

## **SIDE TOUCH, SIDE TOUCH**

1-2                      Step right to right side, touch left beside right  
3-4                      Step left to left side, touch right beside left

**REPEAT**
